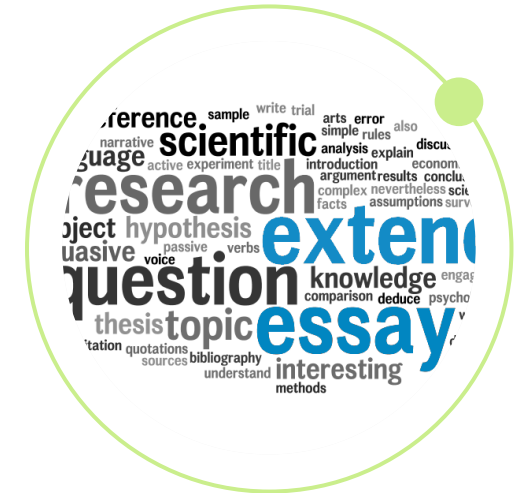

Theory of knowledge

Theory of knowledge (TOK) is assessed through an oral presentation and a 1,600 word essay.



EE

Extended essay



Research paper of up to 4000 words

How does the grading system work?



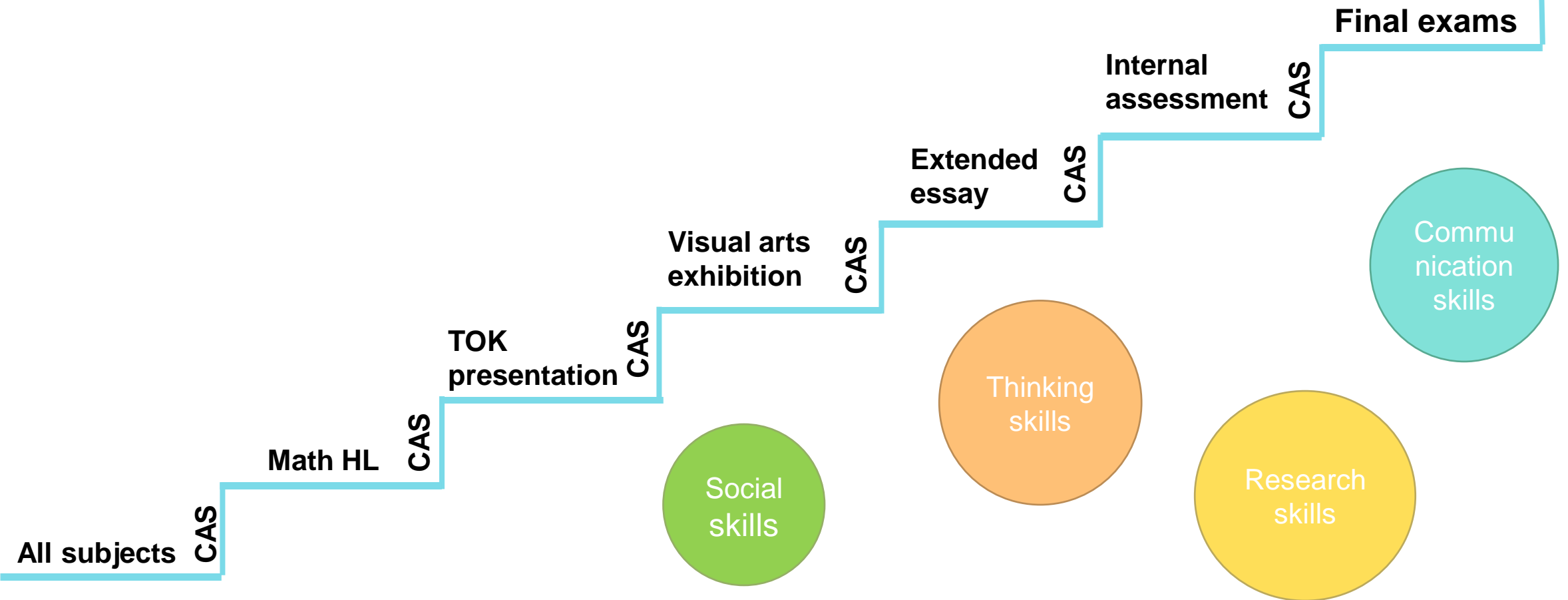
- Subjects are graded on a scale from 1 to 7
- To pass the IBDP one must score at least 24 points
 - ✓ 12 points in three HL subjects
 - ✓ -Not more than three subjects at grade 3 bellow
 - ✓ -Grade 1 is not acceptable
- Maximum 45 points (6 subjects X 7 plus 3 for EE and TOK)

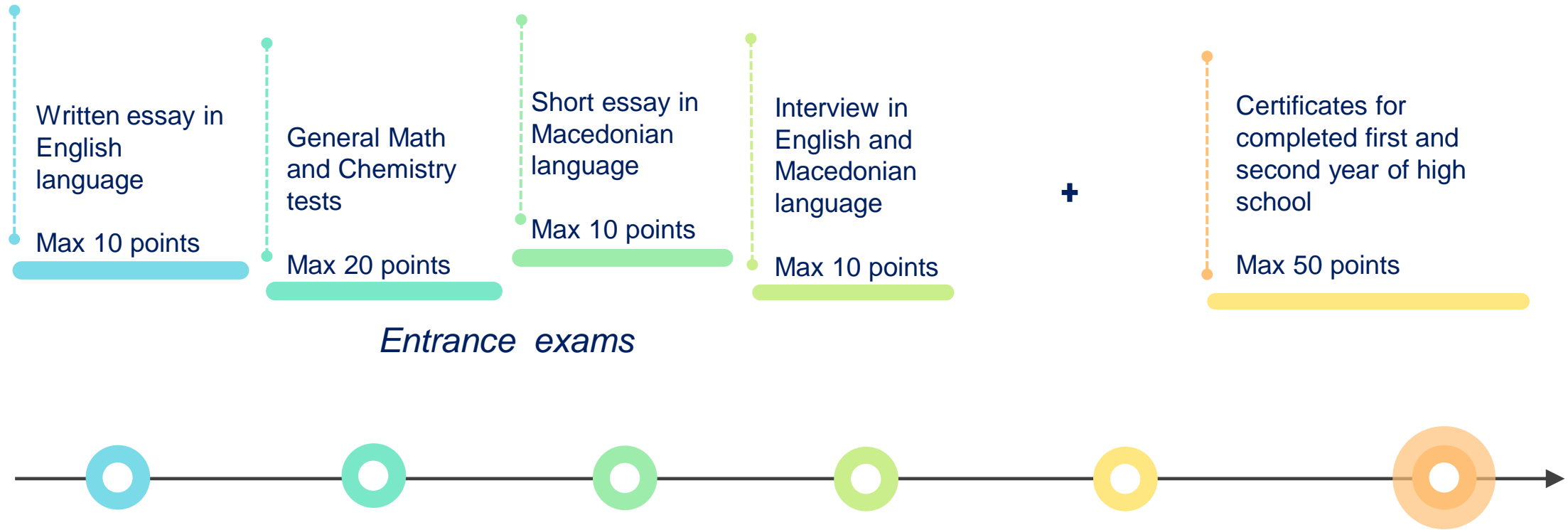

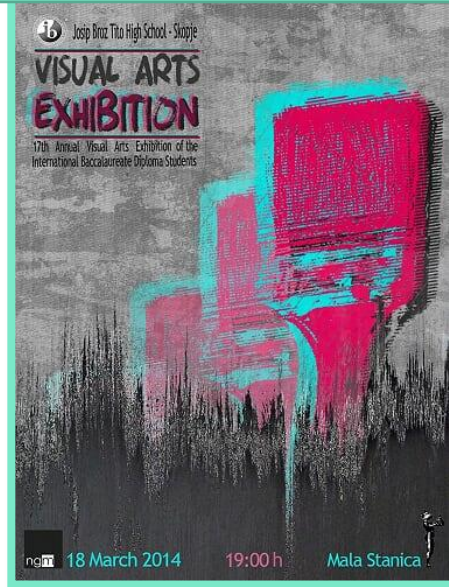
